May 13, 2023



Poultry Testing

All poultry (except waterfowl) are required to show proof of being P-T clean by one of the following: Originate from a certified U.S.

Pullorum-Typhoid clean flock

 Test negative at check-in of the county fair when the county has been designated by KDA-DAH for surveillance. Routine surveillance testing will be performed for each county fair a minimum of once every 5 years.

The state has moved to this new schedule where they will test each county every 5 years. Meade county is scheduled for P-T testing in <u>2025</u>.

Reminder! Youth need to be enrolled in Foods and also have an item judged in foods to be able to participate in the pie and cake auction at the fair!

NEW 4-H Foods & Nutrition Rule for Frostings & Fillings at the Kansas State Fair

Please note that there is a *NEW* 4-H Foods & Nutrition Rule for the 2023 Kansas State Fair. The new rule is as follows: For food safety purposes, any entries with frostings and fillings must calculate the amount of sugar in the frosting/filling recipe only. Calculation must be attached to entry, or the placing will be lowered one ribbon when judged. Frosting and fillings need to contain more than 65% sugar for safety.
