4-H Club Day is an event which gives participants an opportunity to tell others about their 4-H projects and demonstrate their talents and abilities. Presentations such as talks, demonstrations, speeches, skits, music and dance are judged and awarded ribbons. Club Day offers the following three divisions.

- Cloverbuds 5 & 6 years old

K-State Junior Producer Days – Manhattan, KS

Junior producer days are hosted by the K-State Department of Animal Science to provide educational material and hands-on experiences for youth, parents, leaders, and extension agents. Various speakers share information on topics such as selection, nutrition, showmanship, fitting, reproduction, feeding, and disease control. Talks, demonstrations, hands-on activities, and door prizes are present at all events. Beef and Sheep days are held in the even years and Swine and Meat Goat days are held in the odd years.

Livestock Weigh-ins – SAVE THE DATE

Beef – Wednesday, March 20, 5-6 pm Small animal – Monday, May 6, 5:30-7 pm

If you are planning to show sheep, goats, beef, or swine at the county fair, you will need to weigh them in at the respective spring weigh-in. Animals that are not weighed in by the date will not be able to show. If you have conflicts, you can make arrangements to have your animal tagged prior to weigh in. Please contact Hannah and she will help coordinate a time with you. We will be using EID tags this year, which are the same tags that are required for state fair!

YQCA Training

In person: March 12th at 10am OR April 18th at 6:30pm



Youth for the Quality Care of Animals is a required course for 4-Hers exhibiting livestock in the county and state fairs. 4-H Youth have the option to take YQCA training online for \$12 or in person for \$3. We highly recommend attending the training in person if possible, as this will be more engaging and hands on. Registration for either type of training will be at https://yqcaprogram.org/. Remember, you must take the pre-test before attending the in-person course.

4-H Camp at Silver Maple Camp AKA WildHorse Camp

June 11-13th at Silver Maple Camp in Kingman

Rock Springs Ranch has many different sessions for rising 3rd-12th graders to attend. This is a different camping



experience than WildHorse Camp, our 4-H Camp put on by the Extension Agents. RSR has incredible facilities and a plethora of fun activities. If your 4-Hers are interested in going to camp with other 4-Hers from Meade County, select the session from June 30-July 3rd. We currently know of one 8th grade girl that will be attending those dates, and she would love to have other Meade County 4-Hers attend with her! Meade County 4-H Council pays \$100 towards your registration, and Town & Country will pay half of the fees for their club members! Camperships (camp scholarships) are also available through RSR. We are also brainstorming some ideas to help fundraise to cover some of the cost of camp.
