

Shooting Sports Disciplines for Meade County  
Must be enrolled in the project before attending any practices

**BB-** Must be 9 years old to be in BB. Can shoot BB until age 14.

- New 4-H members (haven't done Air Rifle) under the age of 14 are encouraged to start with this discipline.
- We have acquired more BB guns, so youth shouldn't have to share guns.
- Course of Fire- 10 record shots in 4 positions (Prone, Standing, Sitting, Kneeling)
- Parents or older siblings must attend to help load.
- There are State Qualifying matches held throughout the state. The Spring state match is usually mid-April.

**Air Rifle-** Must be 9 years old to shoot air Rifle until Age 18- We have many Air Rifles.

- Air Rifle is much heavier than BB gun
- Course of Fire- 20 Record Shots in 3 positions (Prone, Standing, and Kneeling)
- Competitive shoots around the state usually starts in February.
- Will practice on Silhouettes also

**Air Pistol-** Must be 12 years old to shoot pistol- We have 4 air pistols

Age 12 & 13- 2 handed

Ages 14-18 1 handed

- Course of Fire- Slow fire, Rapid fire, and Silhouettes
- Winter practices- Will start in March. There are State Qualifying matches held throughout the state. The Spring state match is usually mid-April.

**Outdoor Sports- Practices will start in late spring or early summer-** More information will come later.

**Archery-** Age 9 We have equipment

**Muzzle Loading-** Age 12- We will have 1 muzzleloader rifle. Must have Air Rifle experience

**Small Bore Pistol** (22 caliber)- Age 13- Must have any safe .22 caliber 22 with scope

Must have participated in Air Pistol and have coach's permission.

**Small Bore Rifle-** (22 caliber) Age 13- Must have any safe .22 caliber 22 with scope

Must have participated in Air Rifle and have coach's permission.

**Shotgun-** Age 10- Shooters must provide own shotgun
